- The Towson Communities Alliance is continuing to work on your behalf. We recently received great news that we have won our case at the Board of Appeals to keep a service station out of the former 1st Mariner building at Joppa and Loch Raven. We expect an appeal but for now we are in good shape.
- The Loch Raven Task force which was convened to develop a revitalization plan for the Baynesville area along Joppa Road will be meeting again online in August 2020. The group has reactivated the Baynesville Business Association to bring local businesses together to work on improvements to this areas. Stay tuned for more good news.
